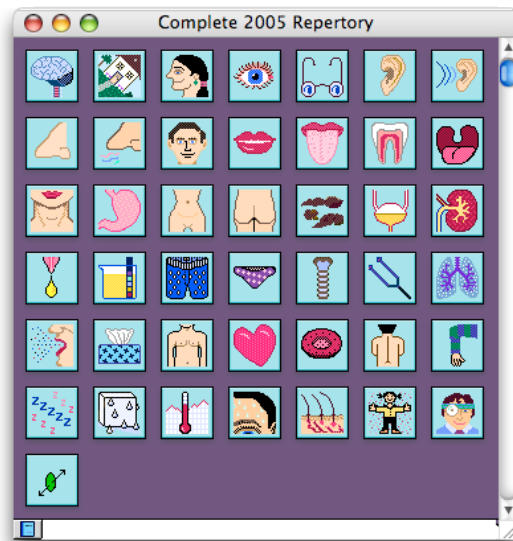


Complete 2005 and Universale V

A short list includes a wonderful mix of insects (giant centipede, dragonfly, fly); sea creatures (goldfish, octopus, salmon, sea wasp, sea-horse, stonefish); birds (canary, condor, falcon, ibis, pelican, road-runner, scarlet macaw, swan, vulture); animals (alligator, koala, mouse, rat, dinosaur bone, camel, dolphin, elephant, horse, lion, wolf); plants (chocolate, hemp, olive, orchid, reindeer moss, vanilla); minerals (alabaster, amethyst, diamond, fool's gold, neon, ruby, sapphire, turquoise); drugs (diazepam, prednisol, tryptophan); virus (aids, epstein barr, herpes); and manufactured items (coca cola, LSD, wine, polystyrene, rubber), etc.

Richer Families: Or think in terms of having complete families: for example, over **fifteen thousand additions** were made to the spider remedies alone (the bird, three black widows, two brown recluses, cross, cuban tarantula, funnel-web, house, orange, orb weaver, red-back, two six-eyed crabs, white tailed, wolf and zebra jumping spiders as well as cobweb. Notice most of the remedies are new, too!

Up-to-date: There are tens of thousands of clinical additions from contemporary homeopaths such as Andre Saine (7,903) and Alphons Geukens (4,500).

Accurate: This is by far the most reliable repertory ever; more than one in four of the remedy additions have been clinically verified.

Boenninghausen: All of the most important of Boenninghausen's writings, including his handwritten additions, have been added. The Complete is the only repertory that has added and fully updated Boenninghausen's rubrics with the latest remedies.

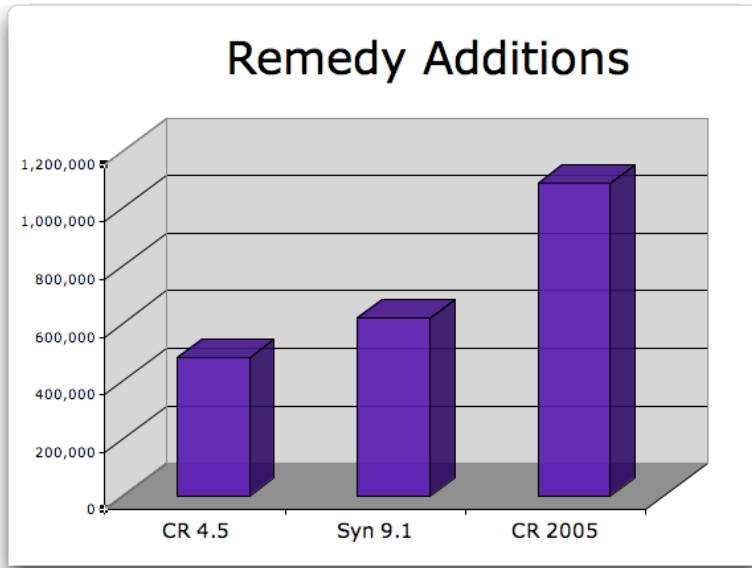

If you're like me, pictures are easier to understand and trust than words. Taking Kent as the base line I've prepared some statistics that show the tremendous advantage of the Complete 2005.

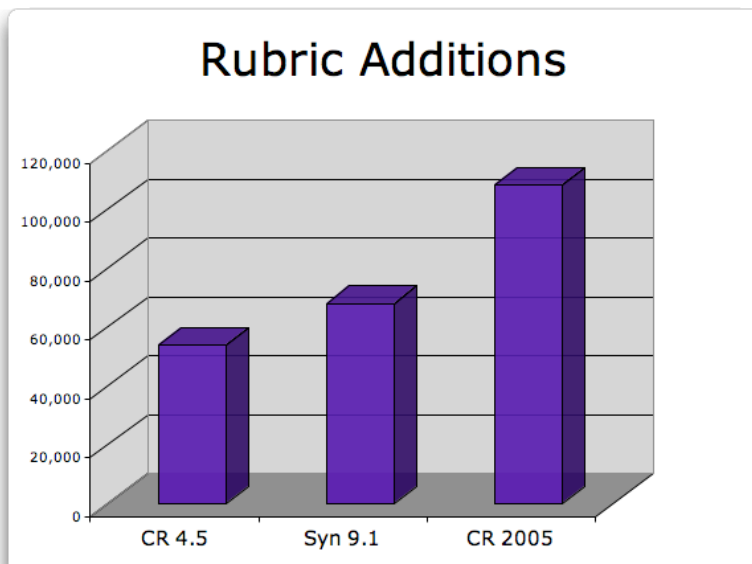
Remedy Additions

Remedy additions are the most important measure of a repertory; the more additions, the more likely you are to find the remedy you need. When you depend on your repertory to help you think of the best remedy, it is vital that it is complete. To put it simply, your ability to find a brilliant remedy will improve dramatically when you use the Complete 2005.



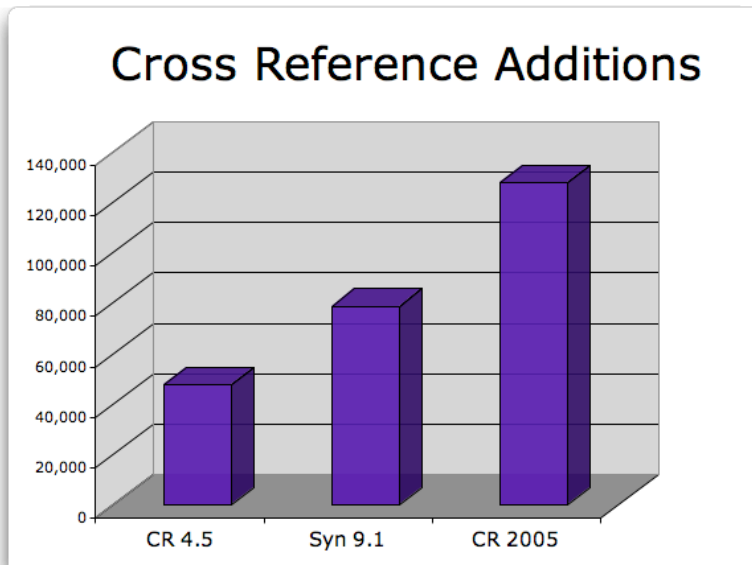
Rubric Additions

The breadth of rubrics defines how well a repertory can match the uniqueness of your patient. The more rubrics that are included the more likely you'll be to find the exact rubric you need.



Cross References

And finally, the more cross references you have, the more likely it is that you'll be to find a rubric when it is expressed differently than you'd imagine it to be.

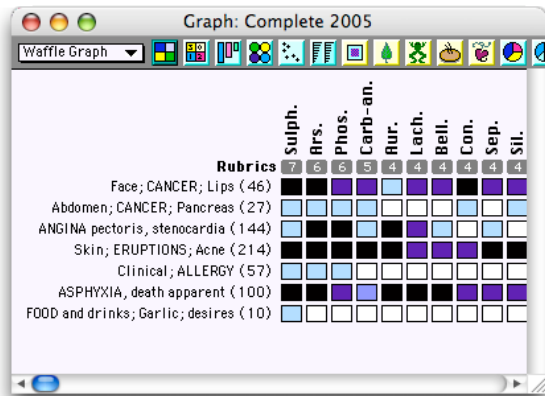
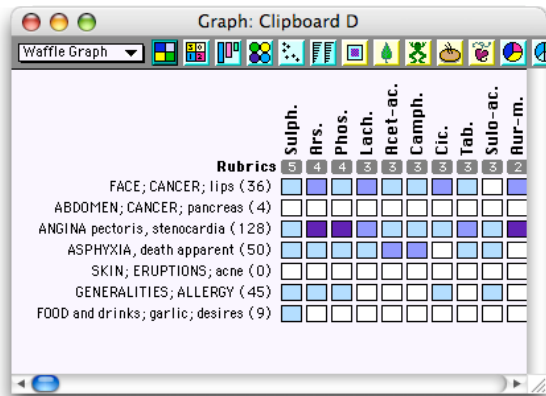
